

# **Photographing, Filming and Recording of Students Policy**

## **Annual Consent Form and Collection Notice**

#### **PURPOSE**

To explain to parents/carers how Montrose Primary School will collect, use and disclose photographs, video and recordings of students, how parent/carer consent can be provided and how it can be withdrawn.

#### **SCOPE**

This policy applies to the general collection, use and disclosure of photographs, video and recordings ("images") of students. It does not cover the use of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV).

#### **POLICY**

This policy outlines the practices that Montrose Primary School has in place for the collection, use and disclosure of images of students to ensure compliance with the *Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014* (Vic). It also explains the circumstances in which Montrose Primary School will seek parent/carer consent and how consent can be provided and/or withdrawn.

As a general rule, use relates to images which are shared and distributed only within the school for school purposes (i.e. ID photos, Sentral), whilst disclosure is used for images which are shared and distributed outside of the school staff and are available to other students, parents/carers and the wider school community.

Montrose Primary School will ensure that parents/carers are notified upon enrolment and at the commencement of each school year of the ways in which our school may use images of students. During the school year there are many occasions and events where staff may photograph, film or record students participating in school activities and events. We do this for many reasons; to celebrate student participation and achievement, showcase particular learning programs, document a student's learning journey/camps/excursions/sports events. We communicate with our parents and school community through the use of newsletters, the school's social media platforms and on classroom blogs and websites.

Montrose Primary School will use student images reasonably, appropriately and sensitively, consistent with our obligations under the Child Safe Standards and our school's Child Safety Policy and Image Consent Agreement. If at any time a parent/carer or student has a concern about the use of any images they should contact the school principal.

This notice applies to photographs, videos (Including live streaming) or recordings of students that are collected, used and disclosed by the school. We ask that any parents/carers or other members of our school community photographing, filming or recording students at school events (e.g.: concerts, sports events etc.)

do so in a respectful and safe manner and that any photos, video or recordings "images" of students are not publicly posted (e.g. to a personal social media account) without the permission of the relevant parent/carer.

## A. Use or disclosure within the school community

<u>Unless you tell us otherwise below,</u> images of your child may be used by our school within the school community, as described below.

Photographs, video or recordings of students may be used within the school community in any of the following ways:

- in the school's communication, learning and teaching tools (for example, emails, classroom websites or apps that can only be accessed by students, parents/carers or school staff with passwords e.g. Sentral, Google Classroom etc.)
- for display in school classrooms, on noticeboards etc.
- to support student's health and wellbeing (e.g. photographs of pencil grip to assist in OT assessments)

## B. Use or disclosure in publications/locations that are publicly accessible

<u>Unless you tell us otherwise below</u>, photographs, video or recordings (including live streaming) of students may also be used in publications that are accessible to the public, including:

- on the school's website
- on the school's social media accounts
- on the school's year level websites
- in the school's newsletter (which is posted on the school's website)
- any school produced promotional material (without names)

Your child may be identified by first name and initial of surname (sometimes grade level is identified) only in these images (or not named at all).

We will notify you individually if we are considering using any images of your child for specific advertising or promotional purposes produced by external organisations (such as newspaper articles, Education Minister's Facebook page).

#### **Privacy**

Photographs, video and recordings of a person that may be capable of identifying the person may constitute a collection of 'personal information' under Victorian privacy law. This means that any images of your child taken by the school may constitute a collection of your child's personal information. The school is part of the Department of Education and Training (**the Department**). The Department values the privacy of every person and must comply with the *Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014* (Vic) when collecting and managing all personal information. #### **Ownership and Reproduction**

Copyright in the images will be wholly owned by the school. This means that the school may use the images in the ways described in this form without notifying, acknowledging or compensating you or your child.



Montrose Primary School understands that parents and carers have the right to withhold permission for our school to use photographs, video or recordings of your child (apart from circumstances where the school is not required to seek consent – see *our Photographing*, *Filming and Recording Students Policy*).

If you have read this notice and are comfortable with the school using photos, video or recordings of your child as described above, you do not need to take any further action.

However, if you have decided that you **do not** want images of your child to be collected or used by our school, **please complete the form below** and return it to the school office. Please note that it may not be possible for the school to amend past publications or to withdraw images that are already in the public domain.
